Transition to Swine 12% Mini Pig Maintenance as desired between 1.5 – 3 years of age.

Gestation and Lactation: Transition to 50% Swine 16% Active Mini Pig and 50% Swine 18% Youth Mini Pig. For higher energy requirements, as in the case of large litter size or multiple breeding's, increase Swine 18% Youth Mini Pig to 60% of the daily intake.

CAUTION: Do not exceed 0.3 mg/kg of selenium in the complete feed.
